Audiological Services

Hearing Assessment (1 Hour)

- · Full audiological assessment.
- · Discussion of results and options available.
- Optional report to GP and / or referrer.

Hearing Aids

The cost of hearing aids can vary from approximately **\$820** to **\$5600** each. In addition,there is a non-refundable fitting fee of **\$565** which covers the initial needs assessment, the fitting appointment and follow-up appointments as required duringthe first 6 months.

For a hearing aid fitting, you will need to attend at least three appointments, and will be given a trial of at least two weeks up to a maximum of 60 days.

Needs Assessment (1/2 Hour)

- · Needs assessment discussion includes budget, expectations etc.
- Recommendation of the suitable hearing aid(s) for you, considering your individual needs, hearing loss, dexterity, vision and budget.
- A quote will be given if you decide to trial hearing aid(s).

Fitting Appointment: (1 Hour)

- Fitting of hearing aid(s) & evaluation of hearing aid(s) performance.
- General instructions in use and care of devices.
- Payment of hearing aid(s), including the non-refundable fitting fee is required at this appointment.

Follow Up Appointments (30 Minutes)

Fine tuning and adjustment of hearing aid(s)

Several appointments may be required in order to achieve the best possible performance and solve any problems that may arise. During the trial period these additional appointments are included as part of the non-refundable fitting fee. Occasionally, different hearing aid makes and/or models need to be trialled before the best possible result is obtained.

If, for whatever reason, a hearing aid trial is unsuccessful, a refund of the cost of the hearing aid(s) will be made. Please note that custom ear moulds are also nonrefundable.

Ear Nurse Services

Ear Wax Removal (15-20 minutes)

- We utilize Oto-microscope suction which is a safe wax removal method.
- We advise clients to use a few drops of olive or almond oil for 1or 2 days prior to your appointment. This will help to soften the wax.

Third Party Funding

Please discuss with our staff funding which may be available for you.

If eligible for funding by either ACC or Veterans Affairs we may require their authorisation before proceeding with appointments.

Ministry of Health (MoH) offers a subsidy of \$511.11 per hearing aid, every six years. Additional MoH funding may be available for those with a severe hearing loss since childhood or those with a community services card who are working or studying. WINZ may offer financial support.

Hearing Aid Warranty and Repairs

Hearing aids typically carry a two-year manufacturer's guarantee against faulty parts and workmanship from date of issue. They do not cover faults caused by accidental damage, wax blockage, moisture or if they are lost (thus personal insurance cover is recommended once hearing aids are fitted). Minor repairs to hearing aids and/or ear moulds may be done at the clinic over the counter.

Unable to keep an appointment

Please advise us if you are unable to attend an appointment at our centre so we can reschedule you. Appointments that are not kept or cancelled without sufficient notification are liable to be charged. Any outstanding debts will incur a collection fee.
